Reminders

WATER: Please ensure your child has plenty of water, especially on days when we have PE.

Curriculum:

Topic work: In The Flamingo Class, we will be approaching our topics through a 'creative curriculum'. By centring learning around one topic area, children are able to apply their skills in a meaningful and purposeful way across the entire curriculum in a variety of ways. Children will learn to adopt a multi-disciplined approach to their work in order to research, investigate, reason and inquire.
