ICT:

Writing for different audiences:

- Editing text from literacy writing to be suitable for a specific reader.
- presenting by manipulating pictures & text.

Art:

Dream landscapes

- paint and collage

Design:

Storybooks

- Linked with ICT, children discover how to create interactive books (e.g.. moving parts, flip-books, etc.)
